Scholarship season is upon us once again.

The Calgary Old Time Hockey Players Association awards annual scholarships to students who are attending secondary educational institutions. In order for a student to receive such an award the following criteria must be addressed:

- 1. The candidates must be attending an accredited secondary educational institution.
- 2. The candidates must submit a transcript of their last semester marks.
- 3. A letter of reference from a teacher or guidance counselor.
- 4. An outline of their past and present community and athletic involvement.
- 5. A brief outline of their future plans.
- 6. Student ID number and SIN number.
- 7. Home mailing address, postal code and telephone number.
- 8. For a son or daughter of a member to apply, the member must have belonged to the association for a minimum of two years and be an active volunteer in association events.
- 9. Successful applicants can re-apply every two years.
